Based on tactful extraction and examination of jobs posted and applied for in a month, it details 'recruitment' as a process backed by hiring sentiments of a recruiter and aspirations of a job seeker.

METHODOLOGY

RecruiteX represents the demand aspects of recruitment. Demand for talent is computed by factoring activities of recruiters on TimesJobs. com. This demand is integrated with numbers collected by our offline team and then segregated according to top industry verticals, functional areas and locations. The base value for the index has been kept



at 100 for the month of December 2010. All RecruiteX values for subsequent months represent the trend of RecruiteX viz-a-viz December 2010. RecruiteX, in its most comprehensible format, is aimed to provide a detailed insight of the recruitment market in India to employers, recruiters and job seekers alike.


Hiring up by 4%, BPO and BFSI top hiring sectors in May 2017.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



ALENT demand was up by 7 per cent during May 2017, reveals latest RecruiteX - the recruitment index by TimesJobs. BPO/ITeS and healthcare/ pharmaceuticals were the top hiring sectors during May 2017. Automobiles and BFSI sectors

also hired significantly during the month. Customer service, tele-calling, doctors, nurses and medical professionals reported significant rise in talent demand. Accounting and finance professionals too witnessed rise in demand. Among key locations, tier II locations posted maximum increase in demand. Bengaluru was the best performing metro in terms of recruitment. Among states, Rajasthan (except Jaipur) posted over 20 per cent rise in demand. Hiring gained momentum for professionals across all experience categories. Candidates having over 20 years of experience posted highest rise in talent demand in May 2017.





Overall, hiring was quick paced during May 2017. Key employment sectors and functional areas contributed to the rise in recruitment activities.

DEMAND

■ **BPO/ITeS** posted 24% rise in talent demand. **Healthcare** sector saw 15% rise in demand.

■ **Customer service** professionals reported over 20% rise in demand.

■ Among top ten locations, **Jaipur** and **Pune** witnessed over 20% rise in demand.

■ Candidates across all experience categories saw active demand; professionals with **over 20 years** of experience posted over 20% rise in demand.

Demand reported rise across most key industry segments. BPO/ITeS and healthcare/pharma were the best performing sectors during May 2017.



■ **BPO/ITeS** registered highest rise of 24% in hiring during May 2017.


■ Healthcare sector posted 15% rise in demand. Consulting services sector reported a rise of 13% in talent demand.

■ Both automobiles and BFSI sectors saw 12% rise in demand. Real estate sector posted 9% rise in demand.

During May 2017, talent demand grew across key functional areas. Customer service and medical professionals were the most in-demand profiles.



Customer service professionals reported over 20% rise in demand.

■ Doctors, nurse and medical professionals witnessed 19% rise in demand.

Accounting & finance professionals saw 8% rise in demand and IT/telecom profile witnessed 6% rise.



■ Bengaluru saw 19% rise in talent demand in May 2017. Chennai posted 10% rise in demand.


■ Ahmedabad and Chandigarh both posted 16% rise. Delhi-NCR witnessed 7% rise in demand in May 2017.



RECRUITMENT TREND BY EXPERIENCE

Talent demand was upbeat across all experience categories, with candidates having over 20 years of experience posting maximum rise in demand.

■ Candidates with over 20 years of experience reported highest rise (over 20%) in demand during May 2017.

■ Professionals with 10-20 years of experience posted 14% rise in talent demand, followed by candidates with 5-10 years of experience with 7% rise.

■ Candidates with 2-5 years of experience witnessed 6 per cent rise, while candidates with less than 2 years of experience reported 3% rise.
